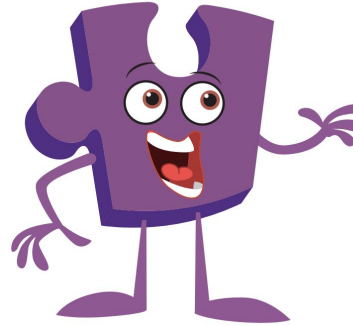

RHE & Science

In Piece 2, the children will learn that a baby grows inside it's mother's tummy. Children may ask questions about this in school and at home. This is not a sex education lesson and therefore children will not learn about conception. A child may ask questions such as 'How does the baby get there?' which would be answered with a response such as 'A baby grows from an egg that the mother has inside her.' You may wish to answer questions at home in more detail, or explain that they will learn more about this as they get older.
